Hagerman, Inc. to build Charis House

FORT WAYNE – Hagerman, Inc. is the general contractor for the \$3.5 million new Charis House for the Women’s Division of Fort Wayne’s Rescue Mission Ministries. The building will be located in the 400 block of Fairmount Place in Fort Wayne.

Construction is scheduled to begin this month, September of 2009, with a completion date of March of 2010. Hagerman, Inc. is honored to be part of this project that allows Fort Wayne Rescue Ministries to increase the number of women and children served who are experiencing a homeless crisis.

The new two-story building will increase the size to approximately 25,000-square-feet and expand the number of available beds from 42 to 78. With updated facilities and more space, the Charis House’s staff will be able to provide additional room for the 75 homeless women and children currently turned away due to space limitations.

Charis House’s mission is caring for homeless women and children by providing them a safe place to acquire the skills and emotional health they need to become successful adults and parents. It is fully funded by grants and private donations. The Charis House does not receive local, state or federal funding. It relies on private donations; regularly applies for grants and receives United Way funding.
