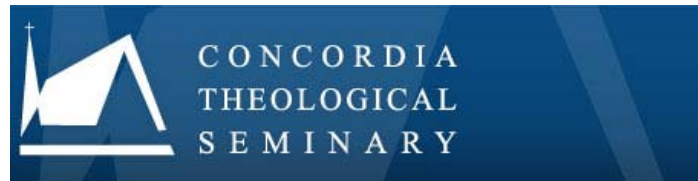

Hagerman, Inc. is selected as the Construction Manager for the Expansion and Renovation to CTS Walther's Library

FORT WAYNE - Hagerman Inc. is named construction manager for the \$7.6 million expansion and renovation of Concordia Theological Seminary Walther's library in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

Construction began September of 2009, with a completion date of March 2010. Hagerman, Inc. is honored to be part of this project that will help fulfill the seminary's mission to "teach the faithful, reach the lost, and care for all."



Currently, the library's collections are stored in different locations on campus due to the lack of space in the library's 15,000 square-foot building. The library also has insufficient space for students to study and staff to work.

Expansion and renovation of the library will add 50,000 square-feet to the 15,000 square-feet currently in Walther Library. It will house the seminary's 175,000 volumes that it currently possesses with enough additional space for another twenty-five years of acquisitions. It will feature a rare book room with a reading room adjoining; expand individual and group study rooms along with creating a room devoted to materials for children and young adults for elementary and high school religion classes. Additionally, an electronic classroom will be expanded to an instructional and retreat space.

"Hagerman played a major role in the construction of Concordia Theological Seminary's campus building in the 1950's. We are excited to be a part of the new library expansion and renovation project," said Mark Hagerman, CEO of The Hagerman Group.
